

RESPAWN OVERNIGHTER

On Friday, May 15th, we will be hosting a Respawn North Branch all-nighter. We understand that this might be the first all night event for some students, so we want to make as many details as we can as clear as possible. COMING AND GOING - Doors open at 5pm on Friday, May 15th. All students are welcome to freely arrive late or leave early up until 10:00pm. However, in order to best ensure the safety of our students, **no students may arrive at Respawn beyond 10 pm unless Respawn staff is specifically notified well in advance with good reason.**

Students wishing to leave after 10 pm must have specific parental permission to do so or must be picked up by a parent. **In any situation, Respawn staff must be notified and aware of the coming and goings of any students entrusted to Respawn's care, for the sake of each student's personal safety.**

Students are more than welcome to head out or be picked up early anytime after 6am. Official end of the all-nighter is 8am.

FOOD - Two meals are provided, dinner around 6:30 pm and breakfast around 7:30 am. Snack stand will be open officially after Bible Study until around 10:30 pm. Students can ask leaders to access the snack stand throughout the night. Students are welcome to bring their own snacks, and there will be free snacks and as always water available throughout the entire night. **Reminder that students need to make sure to be throwing away garbage and are to leave every accessed area of the building better than the way they found it.**

SLEEP - Students are not required to sleep, however, they are welcome to. The Sanctuary will be off limits all night to all activities, and will be the reserved space for anyone wanting to catch a little sleep. While we cannot guarantee the pews will make great beds or that the building will be quiet the entire night (i.e. during the nerf war). Students are welcome to bring a pillow or blanket if they would like. Respawn will not provide any pillows or blankets.

NERF WAR - We will be doing our biggest nerf war yet, using most of the building. Certain areas will be off limits for the nerf battle (i.e. Sanctuary, Kitchen, Gym, Bathrooms, Offices) to make sure we are respecting students who do not wish to participate and to ensure safety for all participants. For cleanliness and ease of use, we will be using Rival ammo capable nerf blasters exclusively. Rival ammo is easy to clean up and hard to break, therefore preventing foam mess and ensuring longevity for purchased ammo. We know those details probably sound obscure, so if parents have any questions regarding this type of nerf gun, please feel free to ask your students (they probably know what this means) or shoot Liam a text or email. Respawn will provide a number of Rival blasters and all necessary ammo, however, students are absolutely encouraged to bring their own blasters, as the blasters Respawn will provide are typically on the less fancy end 😊.
