

## **Accountability Questions**

- 1. When was the last time you made a crude joke? Or laughed at one?
- 2. When was the last time you sat through a sexual scene on television?
- 3. Do your eyes look over someone attractive in a way that would make them uncomfortable if they noticed?
- 4. Are there dirty/coarse words in your vocabulary which link you to the world and not to Christ?
- 5. Do you read books that tell stories of immorality and rationalize your enjoyment of them?
- 6. Do you go places where the sexual atmosphere is thick, and not feel deeply troubled about it?
- 7. Are you now, or have you ever struggled with an attraction or a relationship with a person who is not your spouse? Or if you are single, with a person who is not a Christian?
- 8. Do people sense the freedom to be "off-color" around you? Do they have the impression that's something you tolerate?
- 9. How do your convictions about appropriate entertainment in sexual matters differ from someone you know who doesn't know the Lord?
- 10. What do you do, that you would not do, if Jesus was right beside you?

## Additional Questions (for Pastors)

- 11. Have you viewed any nudity or partial nudity since the last time we talked?
- 12. Have you gratified yourself sexually in any way outside of marriage?
- 13. Have you had a conversation with a member of the opposite sex that would make your spouse uncomfortable if they heard it?
- 14. Have you spoken flirtatiously with a member of the opposite sex since the last time we met?
- 15. Is there any relationship in your life that is encroaching on the fidelity, sanctity and singularity of your marriage relationship?
- 16. Is there a conversation that you find yourself looking forward to in a way that extends beyond the boundaries of friendship?
- 17. Is there a person that you are going out of your way to see at work or in the office just because that opposite-sex conversation pleases you, in a way that's different than the other women that you know?
