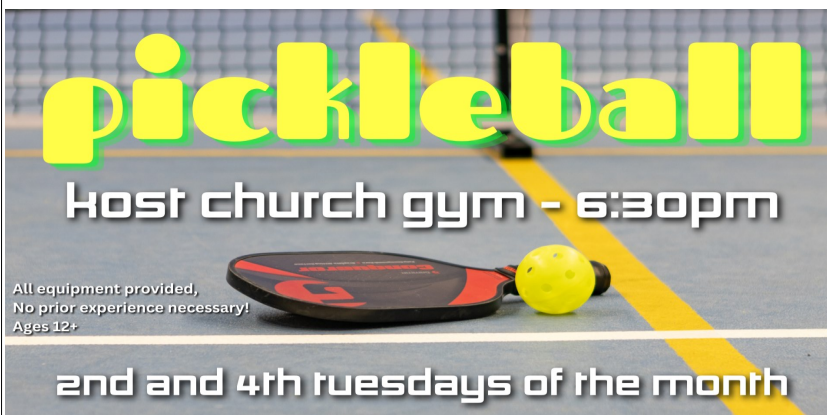
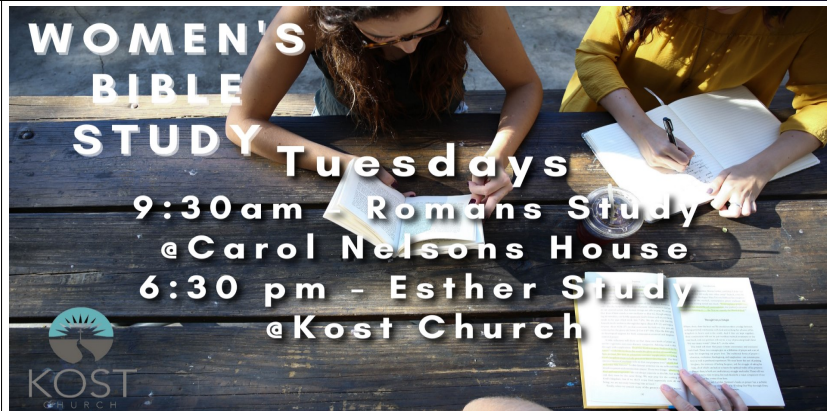

CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING
 MAKE PLANS TO ATTEND

Kost Church's October Business Meeting has been scheduled for Sunday, October 29th at 11 am (during Sunday School time). During our October business meeting we as a congregation decide upon our next year's ministry spending plan (budget), vote on business of the church, and discuss the more practical aspects of our church (ministry items are most often discussed at our January Congregational Meeting, but not always). Every individual of Kost's congregation is both invited and encouraged to attend this meeting. Only members of Kost Church are allowed to vote.

In addition to presenting next year's ministry spending plan (budget) for the congregation's approval, the elders would like to bring forward for approval the following motion:

THE ELDERS OF KOST CHURCH PROPOSE THE SELLING OF THE APPROXIMATELY 5 ACRE PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED ACROSS THE ROAD FROM THE CHURCH TO SUPPLEMENT THE CHURCH'S GENERAL FUND SO AS TO ENCOURAGE AND FACILITATE THE MINISTRY GOD HAS ENTRUSTED TO OUR CHURCH. PER THE BYLAWS OF KOST CHURCH, THE ELDERS ARE SEEKING A 2/3RDS VOTE OF MEMBERS PRESENT TO GIVE AUTHORITY TO THE ELDERS TO CARRY OUT THE SALE OF THIS PARCEL OF PROPERTY.

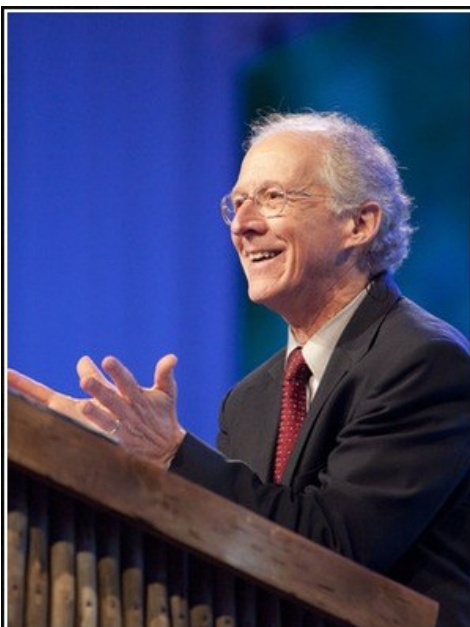
